Here are a few things to note for our term ahead. Thank you for your continued support over the Spring Term, I look forward to welcoming you into class over the summer term to share some learning with your children. Here are a few reminders about homework and reading.

<u>Homework</u>

Homework (English and Mathematics) will continue to be set on a Friday via Seesaw and will be due in by Wednesday of the following week. We encourage parental involvement in homework. However, if they do need further support, please don't hesitate to send a message on Seesaw or via email jprice@goodrich.hereford.sch.uk.

Book reviews will continue to be sent home on Tuesday for you to share a story together. The children love sharing their reviews with the class and they are also very proud of writing their own reviews. However please ensure that presentation is still of a good standard using a pencil where possible.

Reading

The children's reading and love of books has developed well over the last 2 terms. Reading books will continue to go home on a Friday. Please return them to school on the following Monday ready for a book change, this is important as it allows the packs to be used by other reading groups.

We have been working on fluency and expression in our reading sessions and reading at home over the weekend will build upon what the children have learnt at school. Please don't worry if you think the book is too easy, they have been chosen to match your child's reading assessment.

We will also be repeating books to aid fluency and comprehension. It is also important to discuss what your child has read to help develop their reading comprehension skills.









Fluency books go home at the end of the second week of reading.

<u>P.E.</u>

A P.E. kit will be required for P.E. on Wednesday and Thursday; however, their full P.E. kit should be in school at all times as we sometimes have these lessons on different days. Please ensure your child has the correct kit for lessons and all items, including their school uniform are clearly labelled. No jewellery is to be worn, and earrings must be removed on PE days please for health and safety reasons.

Forest school

We have Forest School every other Monday (please see the school app or newsletter for dates). All children need to wear clothing with arms and legs covered. Please ensure they have a waterproof coat/ waterproofs and wellies just in case. We have very limited spares.
