Homework

Homework will continue to be uploaded on Seesaw and sent home in Homework books on a Friday, for it to be completed by Wednesday of the following week. We encourage parental involvement in homework. Home Library book reviews will continue to be sent home on a Tuesday for you to share a story together. These will need to be handed in on Friday of the same week. The children will have the opportunity to share their book reviews with the class during the week.

Reading

We are so proud of how well all the children are reading, their fluency and expression is so lovely to listen to, the children are developing a love of reading! Reading books will continue to go home on a Friday. Please return them to school on a Monday ready for a book change.

Fluency and expression continue to be a key focus in our reading sessions and reading at home over the weekend will build upon what the children have learnt at school. It is also important to discuss what your child has read to help develop their reading comprehension skills. Each book has been carefully matched to your child.

P.E.

A P.E. kit will be required on a Wednesday and Friday; however, their full P.E. kit should be in school at all times as we sometimes have these lessons on different days. Please ensure your child has the correct kit for lessons and all items, including their school uniform, are clearly labelled. For health and safety reasons please do not allow your children to wear jewellery, stud earrings are allowed but must be removed on P.E. days. Thank you.
